## FROM THE PRESIDENT

As the 2010 shooting season winds up, I would like to take this opportunity to remind every one that starting January 1<sup>st</sup> we will begin accepting membership renewals. Dues renewal for 2010 are \$50.00 for members, \$15.00 for spouse renewals and if you put in a minimum of 20 hours work at the Range in 2009 you qualify for a reduced membership of \$15.00. Dues can be paid at the Public Range on Saturdays and Sundays from 1:00pm to 5:00pm, at Paducah Shooters Supply during normal business hours, or mailed in. If you mail your dues in be sure to enclose a self addressed stamped envelope so we can mail you your new membership card. If however your Range Orientation is due, you will not be issued a new membership card until you have had a new Range Orientation. Deadline to pay dues is March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010. ### The Matewan Massacre

Matewan is a small town in the western coalfields of West Virginia along the Tug Fork River. In the spring of 1920, the United Mineworkers Union was trying to organize the miners in Logan, Mcdowell, and Mingo counties. Miners who joined the union were fired and thrown out of company owned houses. On May 19, 1920, 13 armed Baldwin-Felts detectives arrived in Matewan to evict miners and their families. The detectives were coal company employees hired to intimidate the miners..Called the "Baldwin Thugs" by the miners, they had a reputation for brutality in other strikes in the area. The Baldwin-Felts men were met by Chief of Police Sid Hatfield, a former miner, his deputy Fred Burgraff, and Matewan Mayor Cabell Testerman. The Baldwin-Felts detectives produced warrants from the Mingo County Sheriff, including one for the arrest of pro union Sid Hatfield. Upon inspection by Mayor Testerman they were declared fraudulent. Unknown to the Baldwin-Felts men, they had been surrounded by armed miners who watched from doorways, windows, and rooftops. It is unknown who fired the first shot, but the ensuing battle left 7 detectives and 4 townspeople dead, including Mayor Testerman and Albert Felts. Hatfield became a local hero and was acquitted of murder charges for his part in the Matewan Massacre. But in the summer of 1921, Hatfield and an associate Ed Chambers were shot dead on the steps of the Mcdowell County Courthouse by Baldwin-Felts detectives. No one was ever charged with the crime
