JPR&P Club October, 2012 Meeting Minutes

CALL TO ORDER: The monthly meeting of the Jackson Purchase Rifle & Pistol Club was called to order at 18:35 on October 15, 2012 at Paducah Shooters Supply, with Richard Roof presiding and about 12 other members present.

INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS: One guest was present, Samuel Justiniano

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES: A motion was made by Gary Lambert and seconded by Ken Stanley to approve the September, 2012 meeting minutes. The minutes were approved by voice vote.

REVIEW OF FINACIAL REPORTS: The club treasurer, Phyllis McCutchen was not able to be at the meeting so a current financial report for the month of September was not available. Richard Roof reported that the club investment account stood at on 7/31/12, and had in it two months later on 9/30/12. Since an official financial report was not available, a motion to accept a report was not made or called for.

OFFICERS ACTIVITY REPORTS:

George Reynolds reported that live rounds were found in the brass buckets on the rifle range. These buckets are for spent brass, not live rounds. If someone has live rounds they want to dispose of, call one of the club officers, or Shooters Supply. Please do not leave live rounds in the buckets on the range. This presents a safety hazard.

Also new target frames for Hi Power and Vintage Rifle matches will be required for next year. The old frames are being left out on the range due to the deteriorated condition of the existing frames on the range for general use.

Richard Roof reported that Lynn had almost completed all the berm work needed on each of the ranges. The work was expected to be complete in the next couple of weeks. He also reported that Page 4 November 2012

the PPC target frames on the pistol range were in the process of being lowered. Mike Turner was working this issue. Lowering the target frames became necessary due to rounds hitting too high on the pistol berms.
