NEWSLETTER AND MINUTES
March 19, 2018 Meeting Minutes
Olivet Baptist Church, 5186 Hinkleville Road/US60, Paducah, KY

The JPRPC meeting was called to order by President Ken Stanly at 6:34pm.

Minutes: MOTION I: Glen Newtown moved to accept the minutes as published. Seconded and approved.

Financial Report: February income was \$645 mostly coming from dues renewal. The month's expenses were \$2,191.85 with primary expenses arising from liability insurance premiums and donations to the MSU Rifle Team and the McCracken High School trap team. Ending fiscal year income was \$7,236.14 comprised of dues and match fees with expenses of \$7,057.47 primarily comprised of administrative expenses, liability insurance premiums, match expenses, and donations. The Club's ending February bank balance was \$5,001.42.

MOTION II: Robert Cantrell moved to accept the Financial Report. Seconded and accepted.

The Murray Foundation-Fred and Phyllis McCutchen Scholarship donation of \$500 has been received by MSU. The scholarship will be awarded in the fall and the Club will be notified as to the recipient.

Budget: Richard presented the proposed Club budget for FY 18/19 that projected revenues of \$5,472 from dues and match income. Expenses total \$4,947 for administrative expense, newsletter, donations, and liability insurance leaving a net of \$525 for the fiscal year.

MOTION III: Robert Cantrell moved to adopt the budget as proposed by Treasurer Richard Roof. Seconded and adopted.

Discipline Reports:

Match Fees: Members were reminded that disciplines may offer the Club members a discount and that the amount is set by each discipline.

The matches and dates for the current and next month will be included in the newsletter. It is advised to contact the discipline chair before the match as to whether there have been any changes in date and time.

Hunter Sight-in: The date was set for the Sight-in as October 27-28, the last weekend of the month. The fee is \$10 for non-members and \$5 for Club members per gun.

High Power: Robert Cantrell said that the latest match was the best financially High Power to date. Shooters from Missouri, Illinois and Kentucky participated with Larry Evans winning with a score of 788. Dennis Sanderson(Ky) was the next highest shooter. Robert said that he and his committee make the matches fun, safe and that participants help each other. He encouraged anyone with a rifle to compete saying if you have a rifle, he would find a category for it, whatever the rifle is.

The CMP sanctioned matches shoot 80 rounds and for M-1 Garand matches, 30 rounds.
