## Paducah Shooters Supply • July 21, 2014 Minutes

The monthly meeting of the JPRPC was called to order by President Richard Roof, at Paducah Shooters Supply Community Building at 6:32 pm. There were 19 in attendance.

**Minutes: MOTION I:** Mike Turner moved to accept the June Minutes. Seconded and approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** Richard reported a balance of \$46,515.00. There still is work to be done on the range. Dues have produced \$21,300.00 and match fees over \$11,000.00 since April 1. Most memberships are in including the law enforcement agencies and the Juniors. As the law enforcement officers change with some regularity, rather than issuing membership cards to wear at the range, they need only wear their badge or Agency ID card.

**MOTION II:** Kenneth Richards moved to accept the report. Seconded and filed.

### CONTINUING BUSINESS:

#### Officer Report:

**Facilities:** Bill Kelly is working on the trap house covers and has put up Handicap Parking signs at the left side of Range #1 and right side of Range #3.

**Newsletter:** Gary Lambert said that postage is payable and that now it may be automatically drawn from the club account by the Post Office. Richard will send a check for the postage and look into automatic withdrawal.

**Website** – Glen Newtown said that Jack Shultz is trying to get the website back up and needs some information. Richard will fill him in on what is needed.

**Public Range** – This weekend orientation was given to four members who will help run the range. They included Lawrence Roussin, Bill Winters, Terry Baird, and Steven Douglass.

#### Discipline Report:

**Junior** - Saturday, July 26 will be a rifle, pistol, archery, and trap match. The June 4-H benefit match did quite well with good out of the county attendance including some who drove three hours to participate. The Juniors need a new storage facility especially for archery and trap. Justin Riley said that the 4-H is willing to pay for the structure to store a combination of Junior's and 4-H equipment. Richard noted that the JPRPC insurance will cover Junior's equipment but not the building of 4-H equipment. There was discussion as to what belonged to which organization. Justin will look into that and will discuss the 4-H as to insurance.

By general consensus: JPRPC will authorize a storage structure at the Public Range, paid for by 4-H, and each group be responsible for its own insurance. There will be an inventory taken of equipment and which organization owns what.

**Bench Rest** - There were 15 shooters at the last match.

**High Power** - The June 14 match was attended by eight shooters.

Pins – September 12 is the last match of the year.

**Vintage** - There were two relays at the last match and that was good considering that it was 4th of July weekend.

### NEW BUSINESS:

**Expanded Range Hours** - There was discussion as to whether to expand the days that the range was open and if so, how many and what days. By general consensus it was determined that the public range could be open on one or two weekday afternoons, Wednesdays and Fridays being most frequently mentioned. Richard will develop a survey to ask members what and when day(s) should be expanded. He will also seek the advice of Shooters Supply.

**Public Day at the Range** – Mike Turner presented an overview of activities, events, and responsibilities for the Range Day, November 1. Richard asked him to put together a committee and report at the August monthly meeting.

#### Review of New Member Recommendations:

Glen recommended the following for membership: Benjamin Bane, Myron Copeland, Max Finn, Mathew Harris, Delmar Meredith, Jeremy Paessler, Robert Thompson, Jim Wolfgang, and Stephanie Pezzullo. Recommendation accepted.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:39 pm.

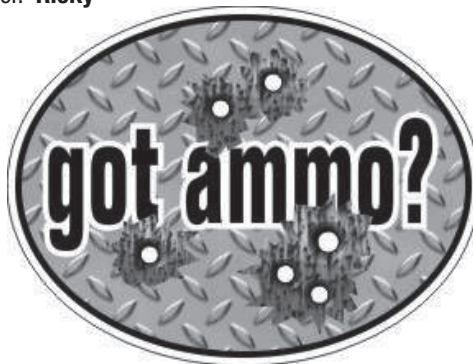

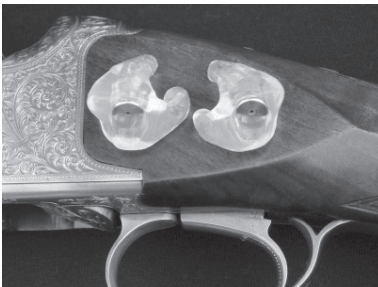
