Officer Report:

Junior Club: The Junior storage building is on hold until spring.

DISCIPLINES:

High Power: Matches will resume in April. George Reynolds noted the gravel in the berm wall between Range 3 and Public Range had been worked on but not finished. Chance McClanahan said that temporarily dirt is being piled at the base and the wall will be redone in the spring.

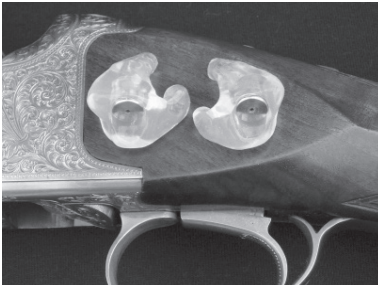
