Jackson Purchase Rifle and Pistol Club Paducah Shooters Supply • April 20, 2015 Minutes

The April 20, monthly meeting of the JPRPC was called to order by President Chance Clanahan, at Paducah Shooters Supply Community Building at 6:30 pm. There were 18 in attendance.

Minutes: MOTION I: Glen Newtown moved to accept the Minutes as printed in On Target. Seconded and approved.

Financial Report: Treasurer Gary Lambert distributed the financial report. The net balance for the month was \$7,565.02. The investment account balance is \$96,831.87.

CONTINUING BUSINESS:

Disciplines: Benchrest - The 18th match had a decent turnout.

Cowboy - It was a good day that included a shooter from Arizona.

PPC - Even though it rained, 18 matches were shot. It was a one-day because of a schedule conflict with Cowboy which shot on the 18th. The president of an Arkansas club visited. He and his wife were here for the Quilt Show.

Vintage - There were 20 matches and all had a good time.

Plates - The first match will be Saturday, May 9.

High Power - Matches are held monthly on the 2nd Saturday. High Power requested an order of 12 sheets of coreplast for target backing.

Other:

Metal Target: Dave Finke reset the Range 1 target against the berm. There was discussion as to placement on Range 3 so as not to interfere with Big Bore and Silhouette targets. When the ground dries sufficiently, targets will be placed.

Range Safety Officer Orientation:

Membership Renewal Dues: Dues are payable are past due. See the April newsletter for the form or stop at Shooters Supply.

Maintenance: Rain has delayed much of the maintenance. Range 3, 200 yard berm needs repair, along with the road, roofs repaired or replaced, and carpenter bee damage repaired or wood replaced. To reduce noise during matches, it was suggested that the ceilings of the shelters be sprayed with a sound absorption material. Color and type of paint was discussed for the Public Range house. May 4, will be a Walk-Thru to assess what needs to be done and the report given at the May meeting. Members who cannot attend, may send suggestions to Chance. He will set up a Range Work Day, later.

Trap: Mike Jones stated that the it was somewhat working, but that it throws fine.

NEW BUSINESS: New Membership: Dave Finke recommended the following for Membership: Wesley M. Beans, Larry Bosecker, Mike Cheek, Ronnie Cheek, Mike Copeland, Daniel L. The recommendation of the Membership Committee was approved.

Checking Account Authorization: Public Range: Due changes in the law in regards to how workers at the Public Range are paid, it was closed to the public. Two members volunteered to work on weekends. When their schedule is set, the Range will reopen to the public.

CCDW: Due changes in the law in regards to how workers are paid, JPRPC CCDW instructors will volunteer their services to teach the class.

Range Safety Officer Trainer: The Club no longer has a Trainer for its RSO's. It was determined that the club needs at least two trainers and as they will be unpaid volunteers, the club should pay their expenses.

MOTION II: Hugo Lang moved that JPRPC pay the expenses of two members to attend the RSO Training School. Seconded and passes.

Website: Jack Schultz asked to have someone else or professional webmaster take over the website as it had outgrown his capability. Various companies were discussed and a report will be made at the May meeting. Jack will continue with the web until someone else can take over within the next two months.

Answering Machine needs to have its messages updated weekly.

Junior Checking Account: The Junior Club funds have been part of the adult club checking account. It was requested that for expediency of access to funds that the Junior Club have a separate account, but managed by the JPRPC Treasurer.

MOTION III: Mike Jones moved to allow the Junior Club to have a separate checking account with oversight assigned to the JPRPC President and Treasurer. Seconded and approved.

Investment Account: Account advisor John Hassell recommended that the President's and Treasurer's names be on the account.

MOTION IV: Ken Stanly moved that the investment account to have the current President and Treasurer on the account. Seconded and passed.

There being no other business, Chance adjourned the meeting at 7:25 pm.

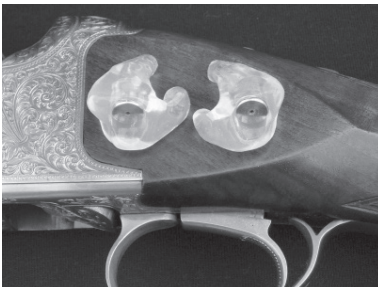
