### **About Cowboy Action Matches – held 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month**

For those of you who have never attended a **Cowboy Action Match**, you have missed a fun event to watch as well as participate in. They shot cowboy guns, use cowboy names and wear outfits that reflect their names.

One aspects of the matches according to SASS (Single Action Shooting Society) is: "a multi-faceted shooting sport in which contestants compete with firearms typical of those used in the taming of the Old West: single action revolvers, pistol caliber lever action rifles, and old time shotguns. The shooting competition is staged in a unique, characterized, "Old West" style. It is a timed sport in which shooters compete for prestige on a course of different shooting stages.

"Each participant is required to adopt a shooting alias appropriate to a character or profession of the late 19th century, a Hollywood western star, or an appropriate character from fiction. Their costume is then developed accordingly. Many event participants gain more enjoyment from the costuming aspect of our sport than from the shooting.

"...alias representative of a character or profession from the Old West or the western film genre...No duplications are permitted."

And the **Ohio River Rangers** serve lunch with all of the cowboy fixin's. The next match is July 20, 9:30-2:00 Range 1 (3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month)
