Jackson Purchase Rifle and Pistol Club Paducah Shooters Supply • May 16, 2016 • Minutes

President Chance Clanahan called the meeting to order at 6:31 pm. Minutes of the May 16, 2016 meeting were approved and second.

Financial Report: A copy of our financial report was not available. President Callahan stated he would send out the financial report within 2 weeks of the May 16th meeting. However, he must work with Wayne Shelton (CPA) for the information. There is approximately \$100,000 in JPRPC bank account.

Membership: Currently, club membership stands at 315 members with two new memberships. Wes Scaggs and Burl Herndon was accepted into the club.

New Business: There was an issue brought forward about the Juniors using storage space not allocated to them. Mike and Justin agreed to solve the issue outside of the meeting.

It was noted that the security lock on the police range was missing. President Callahan stated he would correct this problem.

Old Business: As been discussed since the March 16, 2016, the JPRPC lease will not renewed after the current lease expires in January 2017. Lynn McCutcheon will be forming a new LLC entity. Discussion continued on our options. There appeared to be agreement that there are only 4 options. They are as follows:

- 1 Dissolution of the club
- 2 Merge or be adopted by another club
- 3 Continue with the JPRPC under the new LLC entity
- 4 Purchase/Lease land for a new club.

Richard Roof suggested committees to be formed to research each option but this was not pursued at this time.

Some additional information was provided by our President Chance Callahan.

- The Juniors would continue to operate as they currently do under our 501 C regardless of what happens to JPRPC.
- If JPRPC continues and hold matches, all match money goes to JPRPC
- Our lead liability currently in escrow is \$42,000.
- Regardless if the club stays or goes, everyone must join the new LLC entity.
- If the JPRPC remains and the club runs matches, match shooters will not be required to join the LLC entity.
- The JPRPC is an established gun club and is grandfathered prior to new EPA regulations. So as long as the land stays as a gun club, the new LLC is still grandfathered in.
- If the JPRPC remains, the LLC entity will not interfere with matches and will work around JPRPC match schedule.
- The rifle range will be extended to 300 yards
- The pistol range will be divided into 3 separate pistol ranges.
- The public range will be open at all times as long as the attendant employed by the LLC entity is on site

Please attend our next meeting on June 20, 2016 to vote on the 4 options presented above on the future of JPRPC.

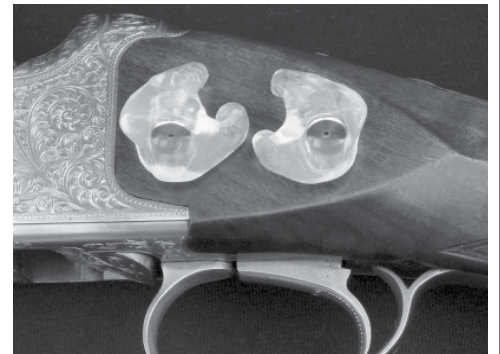
