Jackson Purchase Rifle and Pistol Club Minutes from February 20, 2017

President Ken Stanly called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Minutes: MOTION I: Mike Jones moved that the Minutes be approved as printed in the online newsletter.

Financial Report: Treasurer Richard Roof distributed the financial report noting that there was a negative cash flow in January of \$1,770.62 (JPRPC and Jr. Clubs combined), but Year to Date a positive \$2,068.27. Paducah Shooter's Supply provided copies of missing invoices from the previous treasurer's records. According to Richard there are no obvious issues discovered yet. The investment report from our investment manager, sent on a quarterly basis, will be received early April.

MOTION II: Glen Newtown moved to accept the report. Seconded and accepted.

DISCIPLINE CHAIR REPORT:

Vintage Rifle: Ricky Emerson reported that even though it was cold, 10 shooters turned out for the first relay and some stayed for the second. Vintage meets the first Saturday of each month. The next match is March 4.

CONTINUING BUSINESS:

Junior Club: Justin Riley stated that the Juniors will sign up March 2, 6:00 pm, at the McCracken Co. Extension Office, New Holt Road, Paducah. He announced that long time 4-H (pistol) volunteer, Tim Cooper died recently.

Membership: Glen stated that he had mailed the new Membership/Renewal form with the cover letter to all of those on the 2016 database. JPRPC Membership card color will be blue for 2017. Glen reminded the members to keep note volunteer hours on the back of the card.

(January 23, meeting motion: "...dues be set at \$20 annually. Any members who assists (10 hour minimum) during the fiscal year at matches or other club activities such as approved public service, will be eligible for free membership dues the following year.")

As always, if you will see the discipline chair, the public range will be available for use.

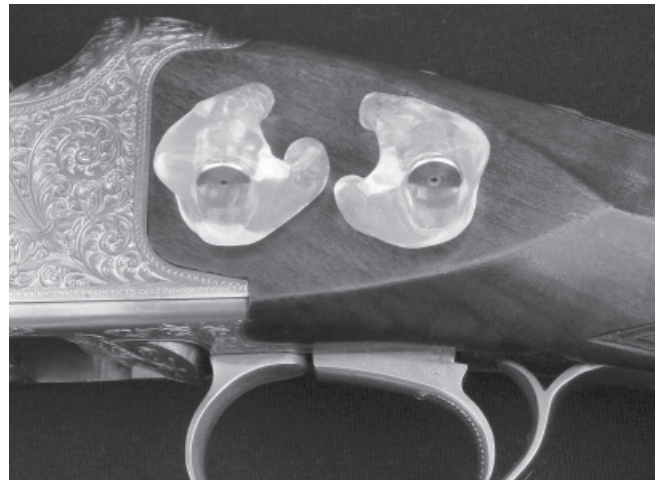
