## Jackson Purchase Rifle and Pistol Club Paducah Shooters Supply • April 18, 2016 • Minutes

President Chance Clanahan called the meeting to order at 6:36.

As Secretary Will Mills was absent, Larry Sexton recorded the minutes.

**Financial Report:** There was no financial report. Chance Clanahan has all of the club files, documents and records in his possession. Wayne Shelton (CPA) will be doing the financials until a JPRPC member steps forward to take this position. Richard Roof volunteered to assist Wayne Shelton with the financials. There will be a Financial Report available for the May 16, 2016 meeting.

The clubs liability insurance will be paid this week. The yearly cost for the liability insurance is between \$4000 and \$5000 per year. The cost is based upon the number of members.

**Match Information:** The newsletter only includes several months of match date and times. However the JPRPC website has the yearly schedule. Additionally, the yearly schedule can be found at Shooters Supply in the front of the store next to the monthly newsletter.

The PPC match had their best match in the last 4 years.

The Cowboy Shoot had 12 shooters.

Best Rest had 8 people shooting and 12 people in the prior match.

**Juniors:** The Juniors had 39 renewals and 21 new registrations. This is about half from last year. The Juniors first match will be in May.

The Juniors received a NRA grant valued around \$5000. The Juniors received the following as a result of the grant.

**1 rifle (22) • 4 air rifles • 10,000 pellets • 10,000 rounds of 22 • + a number of shotgun shells**

The Juniors have an account balance of \$8,069.32

**Continuing Business:** Discussion continued about the future of JPRPC. It was agreed to have an informational discussion at the May 16,2016 meeting with a members vote on the June 20, 2016. meeting. However, if attendance is low at the May 16 meeting, we may opt to vote on the options at the May 16 meeting.

As explained at the March 21, 2016 meeting and discussed further at the April 18, 2016 meeting, McCutchen Farms is not renewing the JPRPC lease. McCutchen Farms will run the range as a LLC entity. The new LLC entity is currently planning to enhance the ranges. Below are a few of the details presented by Mr. Len McCutchen during the March 21 meeting.

- Range membership in the new LLC entity is planned to be between \$50 to \$100.
- The new LLC entity welcomes JPRPC members but they must be paying members of the LLC entity.
- The new LLC entity will allow club matches to continue.
- The new LLC entity is planning construction of new/improved buildings and ranges.
- The new LLC entity will have an attendant on duty while the range is open.

The JPRPC officers met on April 28, 2016, to discuss options available to JPRPC. The officers arrived at 4 options.

1. Dissolution of JPRPC.
2. Continue as a club within the new LLC entity.
3. Purchase or lease land and rebuild our club from the ground up.
4. Merge with or be adopted by a neighboring club.

If JPRPC continues, the members must decide what the role and purpose of the club will be.

It was agreed that Larry Sexton compose a letter concerning the lease issue and the letter is to be mailed to the paid voting members of the JPRPC.

**NEW BUSINESS:** During the JPRPC officers meeting held on April 28, 2016, flowers were sent for Gary Lambert's family and friends from the JPRPC.

The Paducah Sun contained an article about the Clay Busters. The Paducah Sun erroneously stated that the Clay Busters were part of JPRPC. The Clay Busters are part of the Jackson Purchase Gun Club.

**New Membership:** Dave Finke presented two new applicants for membership. The two new members are Frank Bosh and Kyle Smith. The two new members were voted into the club. There are 304 JPRPC members as of the April 18, 2016 meeting. However there are 61 members requiring Range Safety Orientation.

**NRA and CMP Affiliations:** It appears that the NRA web site does not have the JPRPC on it. Chance Clanahan agreed to follow up on this with NRA. The CMP affiliation is up to date.

**Scholarship named for Gary Lambert:** The club voted on providing a \$500 scholarship in honor of Gary Lambert's dedication to JPRPC. There was one nay vote from the membership meeting.

The meeting concluded at approximately 7:40 PM.

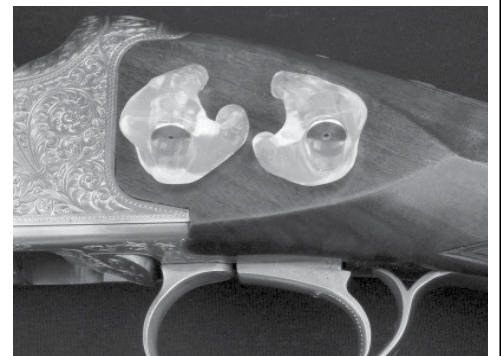
