MEMBERSHIP RANGES AND IS ACCESSED THROUGH A FENCE GATE.

ALL SHOOTERS MUST REGISTER WITH THE RANGE ATTENDANT LOCATED IN THE OFFICE BUILDING ON THE PUBLIC RANGE, THE PUBLIC RANGE FEATURES HANDGUN TARGET DISTANCES OUT TO 25 YARDS, RIFLE DISTANCES OF 100 YARDS, AND A TRAP FACILITY FOR SHOTGUN.

SHOOTERS MUST BRING EAR AND EYE PROTECTION, FIREARM, AND AMMUNITION. SOME TARGETS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE PUBLIC RANGE SHED. FEES ARE \$6.00 PER HALF HOUR, \$9.00 PER FULL HOUR AND \$24.00 FOR ALL DAY FOR HANDGUN AND RIFLE. TRAP FEES ARE \$5.00 PER 25 BIRDS.

Paducah Shooters Supply • August 18, 2014 Minutes

The monthly meeting of the JPRPC was called to order by President Richard Roof, at Paducah Shooters Supply Community Building at 6:31 pm. There were 14 in attendance.

Minutes: As the newsletter has not been sent, the minutes for July will be approved at the September meeting.

Treasurer's Report: Richard reported July had been a good month with \$3,380 received in adult dues and \$1,125 in Adult match fees and \$2,371 in Junior match fees. The Public Range trap showed a positive cash flow for the month.

MOTION I: Glen Newtown moved to accept the report. Seconded and filed.

CONTINUING BUSINESS:

Officer Report:

Facilities: Bill Kelly said that the trap lids are easily rolled back and forth now, and that Mike Jones will replace electrical work.

Website – The website is back up though not everything has been updated. The officers and chairmen were asked if they wanted to have email addresses on the web. Glen Newtown explained that each person's address would be in the club name, not show a personal email. The consensus was that a listing of names and emails should be included.

Expanded Range Hours – Richard reported that by a slim margin the poll taken as to whether to add a third Public Range favored Wednesday. Bill Kelly said that he would work whatever day and time was decided upon.

MOTION II: Glen Newtown moved that JPRPC authorize up to \$500 to promote the expanded days and hours of operations of the Public Range. Seconded and adopted. It was proposed that the starting date be Wednesdays, starting September 3, open noon-5:00 pm

Public Day at the Range – Mike Turner stated that there were two dates possible for the event – November 1 and in the spring. The consensus was that there was not enough time to plan for it by November 1.

Discipline Report:

Junior – Justin Riley requested that the ranges be mowed before the last match of the season on Saturday. The matches are starting to draw shooters from 3-3.5 hours drive away. Practices are going well and 45 Juniors are going to the state mate to compete in archery, rifle, pistol and trap. Justin praised parents and coaches for their hard work with the Juniors.

The proposed equipment storage building to be purchased by 4-H, is a 12x24' portable wooden building with a garage door that will be set up behind the carport on the Public Range.

IDPA – Chance Callahan talked with the IDPA regional director about sponsoring a match this fall. The director wants to come up to look at the facility and to talk about what is needed for a match.

NEW BUSINESS:

Rifle Rental – Rifles are available for rent at the High Power and Vintage matches only. There was a question as to whether the rate was too high or should continue at the current rate of \$10.

MOTION III: Chance Clanahan moved that the first time a rifle is made available to a shooter there be no fee, thereafter the shooter must pay the rental fee. Seconded and approved.

Review of New Member Recommendations – Glen recommended the following for membership: Alexander Bailey, Ashley Bailey (spouse membership), Rick Dorris, Mike Glenn, Scott Davis, and Chris McDaniel. Recommendation approved.

OTHER:

Member ID – Each member is to wear the current membership card where visible when on the club range. David Finke noted that this is not being done and proposed giving members a lanyard and card holder to wear and presented an estimate as to the cost.

MOTION IV: Gary Lambert moved that lanyards and membership card holders be made available to all members the first year and all new members thereafter. Seconded and approved.

MOTION V: Gary Lambert moved that JPRPC spend no more than \$2,600 for the purchase of 1,000 lanyards and membership card holders. Seconded and approved.

Range Orientation – David Finke will be added to the list of RSOs. He will provide range orientation by appointment only.

Membership list – Stephen Douglass asked for a list at the Public Range house to double check who is a member. When a match is on a club range that a member wants to shoot, the member may shoot at the Public Range without paying.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:33 pm.

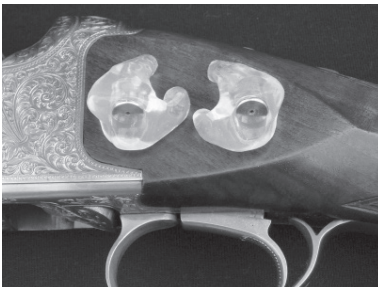
