

2020 APPROVED HIGHPOWER RIFLE MATCHES

SPONSOR: Jackson Purchase Rifle & Pistol Club; 3919 Cairo Road; Paducah, KY 42001

RANGE LOCATION: Paducah, KY. Take exit No. 3 off I-24, the Cairo Road / Highway 305, exit. The club range is approximately 1.4 miles east of I-24 on the north side of Cairo Rd, just past Paducah Shooters Supply.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all club members, NRA members, and the shooting public.

ENTRY FEE: Adults \$20, Juniors \$10. **Advance entry is not required.**

ENTRIES CLOSE: Entries will cease at 11:00 the day of the match.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded at the time of registration. Matches will normally consist of one morning relay and one noon relay if necessary. Each relay is limited to 10 shooters.

RULES: NRA highpower rifle rules shall govern. A plug type scoring gage will be used for scoring disputes.

RIFLE: Any Rifle, NRA highpower rifle rule 3.2.

AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition, NRA highpower rifle rule 3.17 (b)

CHALLENGE: No challenge fee will be charged. Scores will be corrected higher or lower as the challenge jury determines.

CONDITIONS: Individual matches only, (No team matches). Range capacity is limited to 20 shooters and advance entries will be given preference. Firing will commence at 9:00 for the morning relay and at 12:00 for the noon relay, if required.

SCHEDULE: Match 1 - 200 yd. slow fire standing, 2 sighters in 2 minutes, 20 shots for record in 20 minutes, SR-5 target.
Match 2 - 200 yd. rapid fire sitting/kneeling, 2 sighters in 2 minutes, 2 ten shot strings, 60 sec. each, SR-5 target.
Match 3 - 200 yd. rapid fire prone, 2 sighters in 2 minutes, 2 ten shot strings, 70 seconds each, SR-42 target.
Match 4 - 200 yd. slow fire prone, 2 sighters in 2 minutes, 20 shots for record in 20 minutes, MR-52 target.
Match 5 - Aggregate of matches 1 thru 4.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used. A current NRA Highpower classification card, temporary score book, or assigned classification acceptable. If 5 or more shooters without classification compete, they will be placed in a separate class. Otherwise they will shoot as Masters.

AWARDS: Plaque for Match Winner (match 5).

GENERAL INFO: Food is not available on the range. Canned soft drinks are available at the stat house for 1 dollar. The Match Director reserves the right to alter the match schedule in accordance with weather conditions, range conditions, or number of competitors. Several motels and restaurants are available just off I-24 at exits 3 & 4. Exit 4 is the exit for highway US 60, the Kentucky Oaks Mall, and the Wal-Mart Super Center.
