

2020 APPROVED SPORTING RIFLE MATCH

SPONSOR: Jackson Purchase Rifle & Pistol Club; 3919 Cairo Road; Paducah, KY 42001

RANGE LOCATION: Paducah, KY. Take exit No. 3 off I-24, the Cairo Road / Highway 305, exit. The club range is approximately 1.4 miles east of I-24 on the north side of Cairo Rd, just past Paducah Shooters Supply.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all club members, NRA members, and the shooting public.

ENTRY FEE: Adults \$20, Juniors \$10. **Advance entry is not required.**

ENTRIES CLOSE: Entries will cease at 11:00 the day of the match.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded at the time of registration. Matches will normally consist of one morning relay and one additional relay if necessary. Each relay is limited to 10 shooters.

RULES: NRA sporting rifle rules shall govern. A plug type scoring gage will be used for scoring disputes.

RIFLE: Any center fire rifle of any caliber as allowed in section 3, with telescopic or other sights.

AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition, NRA sporting rifle rule 3.17 (a,b)

CHALLENGE: No challenge fee will be charged. Scores will be corrected higher or lower as the challenge jury determines.

CONDITIONS: Individual matches only, (No team matches). Range capacity is limited to 20 shooters and advance entries will be given preference. Firing will commence at 9:00 for the morning relay and at 11:00 for the second relay, if required.

SCHEDULE: Match 1 - 100 yd. slow fire prone, 8 shots for record in 8 minutes, SR-1 target.
Match 2 - 100 yd. slow fire standing, 8 shots for record in 8 minutes, SR-1 target
Match 3 - 100 yd. rapid fire sitting/kneeling, 2 four shot strings, 30 sec. each string, SR-1 target.
Match 4 - 100 yd. rapid fire prone, 2 four shot strings, 30 seconds each string, SR-1 target.
Match 5 - Aggregate of matches 1 thru 4.
Sighting period will be 5 minutes unlimited sighting shots prior to starting the match, no sighting shots thereafter.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used. A current NRA Sporting Rifle classification card, temporary score book, or assigned classification acceptable. If 5 or more shooters without classification compete, they will be placed in a separate class. Otherwise they will shoot as Masters.

AWARDS: Entry fee is waived if competitor brings item of approximately \$20 value to be used for awards.

GENERAL INFO: Food is not available on the range. Canned soft drinks are available at the stat house for 1 dollar. The Match Director reserves the right to alter the match schedule in accordance with weather conditions, range conditions, or number of competitors. Several motels and restaurants are available just off I-24 at exits 3 & 4. Exit 4 is the exit for highway US 60, the Kentucky Oaks Mall, and the Wal-Mart Super Center.
